Recommendation #2: develop and implement opportunities for training

The OFA group recommends a variety of training methods be offered. In brief, training should be available to encourage qualified tradespeople to upgrade their skills to current standards. Training programs should be available for people to become certified if they are not already, or to become qualified oil-burner mechanic journeypersons. The existing apprenticeship program should be enhanced and delivered in the Yukon.

- *What would be the best way(s) to offer it? (for example, online, via teleconference, satellite campus, etc...)*

- *Who should provide the training in your community?*

- *In your opinion, would there be interest in your community for this training?*

Recommendation #3: create an Act specific to oil-fired appliances

The OFA group recommends that permits be required to install or modify oil-fired appliances. The permits would be issued by the Yukon Building safety branch or another approved authority. In order to obtain a permit, the person or company would first need a license. In order to obtain a license, they would need to be a certified oil burner mechanic or have one on staff.

It would be the owner's responsibility to ensure their oil-fired appliances are installed and maintained by licensed oil-burner mechanic journeypersons (as per CSA B139 as amended from time to time).

Focus questions:

- *In your opinion, how can this legislation best address oil-fired appliance safety?*

- *Are the proposed rules sufficient? Too much? Not enough?*

- *When should the Act be put in place?*

- *How much time should the industry be given to meet the demands of the Act?*

- *Do you feel the oil fired appliances in your community are already properly installed and maintained now?*
